

After hearing all of the testimony and evidence presented, and after having resolved any and all conflicts therein, the undersigned Judge of Compensation Claims makes the following findings of fact and conclusions of law: The issue for determination is the amount of costs the E/C is entitled to as a result of prevailing on petitions for benefits filed by claimant on 5/26/10, 6/18/10, and 9/28/10.

Rule 60Q-6.124(3) (3) provides that "The Statewide Uniform Guidelines for Taxation of Costs in Civil Actions shall be considered by the judge in determining the reasonableness of an award of cost reimbursement." As I indicated in my oral ruling at the hearing, and taking into consideration the policy expressed in the guidelines of "reducing the overall costs of litigation and of keeping such costs as low as justice will permit", I find that the E/SA is entitled to reimbursement of costs from the claimant in the amount of \$3,150.14.

WHEREFORE it is hereby **ORDERED** and **ADJUDGED** that claimant is ordered to pay the E/SA \$3,150.14 for reimbursement of its costs.
